Feast Day of St Lucy: 13 December
Disciples Retreat followed by 5:15 PM Mass (Bilingual)



St. Lucy was born in Syracuse in Sicily, a large island off the "toe" of Italy, in the year 281 or thereabouts. Lucy's parents are thought to have been wealthy nobility, although her father, of Roman origin, died during her childhood.

At some point, Lucy's mother, Eutychia, developed a disease, probably dysentery, which caused her to suffer from years of poor health. Lucy, who had taken up Christianity, persuaded her mother to make a pilgrimage to the tomb of St. Agatha, less than 50 miles from their home in Syracuse. Agatha had been martyred 52 years previously, and there had been many reports of miracles granted through her intercession. Sure enough, her mother was cured, and Lucy persuaded her mother to allow her to distribute a large part of their wealth to the poor in thanks for her cure.

However, her mother was less accommodating on the issue of Lucy's arranged marriage. Early in her life, Lucy had consecrated her virginity to God, yet her parents had betrothed her to a pagan youth whom her mother still insisted she should marry. Hearing of Lucy's refusal to marry him and of her giving away of her family's wealth, the youth denounced her as a Christian to Paschasius, the Governor of Sicily.

Lucy was brought before Paschasius and readily confessed her Christianity. She was condemned to death, but was first to be sent to a brothel as punishment for her insistence on virginity. However, her immovable faith in God was made visible: her persecutors could not move her, even when a team of oxen was brought in to drag her away. Next, firewood was piled around her, but Lucy could not be burned. Finally, Lucy was martyred by a sword cast through her throat.

A legend has been passed down concerning St. Lucy's eyes. It is said that the youth to whom she was betrothed was so enamored of Lucy's beautiful eyes that Lucy plucked them out in the hope that he would no longer want to marry her. Sometimes it is said that her eyes were removed as part of her martyrdom. In either case, Lucy is often depicted holding a plate upon which her eyes are placed as well as holding a palm of martyrdom in her other hand. Because of this, St. Lucy is patroness of the blind and of eye problems.

Fiesta de Santa Lucía: Diciembre 13

Retiro de Discípulos y Misa a las 5:15 PM (bilingüe)



Santa Lucía nació en Siracusa, Sicilia, una isla grande en frente de la “punta del pie” de Italia, aproximadamente en el año 281. Se cree que los padres de Lucía eran ricos y de nobleza, aunque su padre, de origen romano, murió durante su infancia.

A cierto punto, la madre de Lucía, Eutychia, desarrolló una enfermedad, probablemente la disentería, la que la hizo sufrir por años de mala salud. Lucía, que había asumido el cristianismo, convenció a su madre a hacer una peregrinación a la tumba de Santa Ágata, a menos de 50 millas de su casa en Siracusa. Ágata había muerto martirizada 52 años antes, había muchos relatos de milagros concedidos por su intercesión. Efectivamente, con la visita a la tumba de Ágata, su madre fue curada, y Lucía convenció a su madre que le permita distribuir una gran parte de su riqueza a los pobres en agradecimiento por su curación.

Sin embargo, su madre era menos flexible en la cuestión del matrimonio arreglado para Lucía. Temprano en su vida, Lucía había consagrado su virginidad a Dios, sin embargo, sus padres la habían prometido a un joven pagano a quien su madre todavía insistía en que debía casarlo. Con las noticias del rechazo de Lucía y el conocimiento de la distribución de las riquezas de la familia a los pobres, el joven pagano denunció a Lucía de ser cristiana a Pascasio, el gobernador de Sicilia.

Lucía fue llevada ante Pascasio y fácilmente confesó su cristianismo. Fue condenada a muerte, pero primero decidieron de enviarla a un burdel, como castigo por su insistencia en la virginidad. Sin embargo, su fe inamovible en Dios se hizo visible: sus perseguidores no pudieron moverla, inclusive cuando trajeron una yunta de bueyes para llevársela. A continuación, amontonaron leña alrededor de ella, pero no la pudieron quemar. Por último, la martirizaron con una espada que atravesó su garganta.

Una leyenda se ha transmitido sobre los ojos de Santa Lucía. Se dice que el joven al cual ella fue prometida estaba tan enamorado de los bellos ojos de Lucía, que Lucía se los arrancó con la esperanza de que el ya no quisiera casarse con ella. A veces se dice que los ojos fueron removidos como parte de su martirio. En cualquier caso, Lucía esta a menudo representada con un plato en su mano donde se encuentran sus ojos y con una palma del martirio en la otra mano. Debido a esto, Santa Lucía es la patrona de los ciegos y de los que sufren problemas de los ojos.
