Holy Week and the Triduum

As Lent draws to a close this Sunday, we prepare to enter the most sacred days of the liturgical year. We relive Jesus' arrest, trial, crucifixion, and glorious resurrection. We walk this path in unity with the Roman Catholic Church and Christians around the world. For all who recognize Jesus as the fullness of God's promise revealed, this journey is more than remembrance—it is a call to live the Good News day by day.

The command to love one another as Christ has loved us is both beautiful and deeply challenging. Some will embrace it with open hearts; others may find it a struggle. But discipleship is not about perfection—it is about persistence. The Paschal Mystery—the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus—is not something we grasp all at once. It is a journey of the heart and soul, unfolding over a lifetime.

Even when we fail to love or forgive, that failure need not define us. True faith is not undermined by difficulty. (Continued on page 4...)



Semana Santa y el Triduo

Al concluir la Cuaresma este domingo, nos preparamos para entrar en los días más sagrados del año litúrgico. Revivimos el arresto, el juicio, la crucifixión y la gloriosa resurrección de Jesús. Recorremos este camino en unidad con la Iglesia Católica Romana y los cristianos de todo el mundo. Para todos los que reconocen a Jesús como la plenitud de la promesa revelada de Dios, este camino es más que un recuerdo: es un llamado a vivir la Buena Nueva día a día.

El mandato de amarnos unos a otros como Cristo nos amó es hermoso y profundamente desafiante. Algunos lo acogerán con el corazón abierto; a otros les resultará difícil. Pero el discipulado no se trata de perfección, sino de perseverancia. El Misterio Pascual —la vida, muerte y resurrección de Jesús— no es algo que comprendamos de golpe. 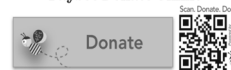

Perhaps People of faith trust that God, the source of all life—human and divine—grants us the grace to rise above our limitations. Through God's divine love, we are empowered to live renewed, becoming more fully the people we were created to be.

At the same time, we cannot ignore the suffering around us. We see deepening conflict, divisions, and hatred. In our own country, we face growing polarization, a failing education system, an economy that leaves many behind, and the erosion of the middle class. Around the world, we witness the devastation of war, the shadow of terrorism, and economic instability. The world is aching for healing. Can we find new ways to promote peace, to share what we have, and to love more generously?

The answer lies within each of us who believe in God's power over sin and death. To believe is to trust that the God who raised Jesus from the dead is still at work—offering us eternal life, even here and now. Trust helps us see God's love at work even amid suffering.

As St. Francis prayed: *"Lord, make me an instrument of your peace. Where there is hatred, let me sow love; where there is injury, pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is darkness, light."* Such trust takes faith, and faith often requires patience. As 1 Peter 1:7 reminds us: *"...so that the genuineness of your faith... results in praise, glory, and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed."*

May this Holy Week and Triduum renew our faith, deepen our trust, and inspire us to live as instruments of God's peace and love in a world that desperately needs both.

Quizás las personas de fe confían en que Dios, fuente de toda vida —humana y divina—, nos concede la gracia de superar nuestras limitaciones. A través del amor divino de Dios, somos empoderados para vivir renovados, convirtiéndonos más plenamente en las personas que fuimos creados para ser.

Al mismo tiempo, no podemos ignorar el sufrimiento que nos rodea. Vemos conflictos, divisiones y odio cada vez más profundos. En nuestro propio país, enfrentamos una creciente polarización, un sistema educativo deficiente, una economía que deja a muchos atrás y la erosión de la clase media. En todo el mundo, presenciamos la devastación de la guerra, la sombra del terrorismo y la inestabilidad económica. El mundo anhela sanar. ¿Podemos encontrar nuevas maneras de promover la paz, compartir lo que tenemos y amar con más generosidad?

La respuesta está en cada uno de nosotros que creemos en el poder de Dios sobre el pecado y la muerte. Creer es confiar en que el Dios que resucitó a Jesús de entre los muertos sigue trabajando, ofreciéndonos vida eterna, aquí y ahora. La confianza nos ayuda a ver el amor de Dios trabajando en medio del sufrimiento.

Como oró San Francisco: "Señor, hazme un instrumento de tu paz. Donde haya odio, que yo siembre amor; donde haya ofensa, perdón; donde haya duda, fe; donde haya tinieblas, luz". *Esta confianza requiere fe, y la fe a menudo requiere paciencia. Como nos recuerda 1 Pedro 1:7: "para que la autenticidad de vuestra fe... resulte en alabanza, gloria y honor cuando Jesucristo se manifieste".*

Que esta Semana Santa renueve nuestra fe, profundice nuestra confianza y nos inspire a vivir como instrumentos de la paz y el amor de Dios en un mundo que los necesita desesperadamente.

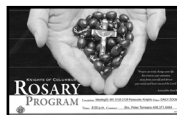
